What is the Oceanic Nutrition Leadership Platform (ONLP)?

The Oceanic Nutrition Leadership Platform (ONLP) is a newly established network of emerging and established nutrition leaders from across the Oceania region that was set up to allow members to develop leadership skills, facilitate collaboration, share knowledge and opportunities, acquire peer feedback, and create new avenues to support good nutrition practice, and capacity building. The ONLP was initiated by the Nutrition Society of Australia in partnership with the Nutrition Society of New Zealand and representatives from the Pacific Islands.

What is the ONLP course?

The ONLP course is an intensive 7-day, biennial program that enables early- and mid-career individuals working in nutrition related fields within Oceanic countries to develop diverse skills and knowledge, and is the gateway to joining the ONLP alumni network. The ONLP course focuses on development of key areas including leadership, communication, team building, social responsibility, influencing policy and Food Industry/Public Health workshop.

The 2nd ONLP course (ONLP18) will be run with 30 participants from 1-8 July 2018 in Northern Queensland (<http://www.genazzanoretreat.com.au/home>) & the closest airport is Cairns; applications will open 31 August 2017 and close 31 October 2017.
